## Bill's Perfect Fertilizer<sup>®</sup>

### Directions for Use

#### **Hay and Pastureland**

Mix Bill's Perfect Fertilizer at 3 ounces per gallon of water. Apply 15-20 gallons of that solution per acre.

#### **Hay**

First application should be early in the season as hay begins to grow. Additional applications should be after each cutting on hay.

#### **Pasture**

Apply when grass comes out of dormancy and begins to grow. Apply again one month later. Apply a third time in the fall. In warm climates, additional applications during the season are beneficial.

#### **Fruits and Vegetables**

##### **Vegetables & Row Crops**

Mix Bill's Perfect Fertilizer at ½ ounce per gallon of water. Apply 20 gallons per acre. Apply as foliar feed as soon as plants are established in the field. Once plants are established, mix at one ounce per gallon and apply every two weeks.

##### **Berries**

Mix Bill's Perfect Fertilizer at ½ ounce per gallon of water. Apply 30 gallons per acre. Apply as foliar feed as soon as plants have new growth or are established in the field. Once plants are established, mix at one ounce per gallon and apply every two weeks.

##### **Tree Fruit**

Mix Bill's Perfect Fertilizer at one ounce per gallon of water and apply monthly. Apply approximately 50 gallons per acre. First application should be made when tree has new growth AND there is no danger of a freeze. Apply monthly or during heavy blooming and fruiting.
